

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE BRANDYWINE SUMMIT CAMP MEETING ASSOCIATION

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is THE BRANDYWINE SUMMIT CAMP MEETING ASSOCIATION.

SECOND: Its principal office in the State of Delaware is located in the City of Wilmington, County of New Castle. The Resident Agent in charge thereof is the Treasurer.

THIRD: The objects and purposes for which this Association is formed are to do any and all things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, viz:

- a. To support public worship, by holding camp meetings according to the usages and doctrines of the Methodist Church.
- b. To acquire by purchase, gift, lease, exchange or otherwise, real estate and personal property, and to hold, manage, and operate the same.
- c. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation.
- d. To buy, sell, own and otherwise acquire and hold stocks, bonds and securities of other corporations, and while the owner thereof to exercise all rights of ownership, including the right to vote thereon.

FOURTH: This Association is organized solely for religious purposes, and shall have no capital stock.

FIFTH: Any cottage owner, whose previous year's ground rental, assessments and other charges have been paid, as evidenced by the books of the Association, shall be eligible for membership in the Association.

SIXTH: The names and places of residence of the original incorporators are as follows:

SEVENTH: This Association is to have perpetual existence.

EIGHTH: The private property of the incorporators or the members of the Association shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatever.

NINTH: The affairs and business of the Association shall be conducted and managed by a Board of nine Trustees, and such other officers and agents as they may elect or appoint under authority given in the By-Laws, provided, however, that each member of said Board of Trustees must be a professing Christian and a member in good standing of a recognized Protestant Church, and that at two-thirds of said Board of Trustees must be members of the Methodist Church.

TENTH: Meetings of the Trustees and of the members of the Association may be held either within or without the State of Delaware, and the Association may have one or more offices in addition to its principal office in Delaware.

ELEVENTH: The Association reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in this Certificate of Incorporation, in the manner now or herein prescribed by statute.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, being each of the original Corporators hereinbefore named for the purpose of forming a corporation, and in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Delaware, entitled "An Act Providing a General Corporation Law", (approved March 10th, 1899) and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do make and file this certificate, hereby declaring that the facts herein stated are true, and have accordingly hereunto set our hands and seals this fifth day of May, A. D. 1919.
