

## Brandywine Summit Camp Meeting Pool Rules

The pool was built to encourage families to spend time together and provide a place of refreshment before and after services.

Cottagers and family members listed on the cottage application may use the pool during regularly scheduled hours without charge. Suggested donations of \$2.00 per guest are accepted toward pool maintenance. Donations should be made at the time of visit. Any guest must be signed into the pool by their sponsoring cottager. That cottager must remain on the campground while the guest is using the pool.

**You swim at your own risk and are responsible for you children and their activities. Violation of these rules will result in immediate removal of the offender from the pool area by the attendant.**

- 1. An attendant or Life Guard must be on duty during all pool use. They have full authority to administer pool rules.**
- 2. Children under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent or guardian when in the pool area.**
- 3. Behavior and language at the pool must be consistent with our Christian witness and the spirit of Brandywine Summit Camp Meeting.**
- 4. Suitable covering will be worn to and from the pool and modest bathing attire is expected. NO two piece bathing suits are permitted. If a visiting guest does not have a one piece suit then a tee shirt is required.**
- 5. Babies MUST have swim diapers on when in the pool.**
- 6. The baby pool is for children age 5 and younger.**
- 7. "Horseplay" is prohibited, including running, shoving, and pushing, dunking or other behavior seen as unsafe by the lifeguard.**
- 8. Diving is prohibited.**
- 9. No pets are permitted in the pool area.**
- 10. Drinks and snacks in safe containers are permitted (NO GLASS).**
- 11. All swimmers must use the pool shower before entering the pool.**
- 12.No touching pumps or equipment.**
- 13. Pool hours are subject to change and vary with programs, weather, work being done and availability of staff.**

**Please take all your belongings upon departure and dispose of your trash. Return the chairs and umbrellas to their closed position.**
